Judgment and Sentence to Illinois Department of Juvenile Justice

The Court having heard the evidence and the minor having been previously adjudged a delinquent minor and adjudged a ward of the court and the Court having been fully advised, FINDS that:

_____ Reasonable efforts have been made to prevent or eliminate the need for the minor to be removed from the home, OR

_____ Reasonable efforts cannot, at this time, prevent or eliminate the need for the minor to be removed from the home,

and removal from the home is in the minor's best interest and welfare.

The Court has received and reviewed evidence concerning efforts to identify a less restrictive alternative to commitment to the Department of Juvenile Justice, and has reviewed and considered factors including:

1. The minor's age;
2. Prior delinquency petitions and adjudications, if any;
3. Results of assessments of the minor;
4. The minor's educational background including educational assessments and services, achievement, and disciplinary history;
5. The minor's physical and mental health, including diagnoses, services and compliance with treatment;
6. Community-based services provided to the minor, and compliance with and outcomes of those services;
7. Services available from the Department of Juvenile Justice that will meet the needs of the minor; and
8. OTHER _____

_____ The parents, guardian, or legal custodian of the minor are unfit or unable, for some reason, other than financial circumstances alone, to care for, protect, train or discipline the minor, or are unwilling to do so, and the best interests of the minor and the public will not be served by placement under 705 ILCS 405/5-740

OR

_____ Commitment is necessary to ensure the protection of the public from the consequences of the criminal activity of the minor.

Secure confinement of the minor by commitment to the Department of Juvenile Justice is in the minor's best interest and welfare.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The minor be committed to the Illinois Department of Juvenile Justice:
 _____ For an indeterminate period as provided in 705 ILCS 405/5-750 (1), (3); and (5) not to exceed (a) that period for which an adult could be committed for the same act, or (b) the minor's 21st birthday, whichever occurs first.
