ORDER FOR SEXUALLY TRANSMITTABLE DISEASES (HIV/AIDS) MEDICAL TESTING
Pursuant to 705 ILCS 405/5-710(9), the Court finds that the minor has been found guilty for an act set forth i said section which requires that the minor undergo medical testing to determine whether the minor has any sexuall transmittable disease.
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, as follows:
A. The minor shall undergo medical testing to determine whether the minor has any sexually transmittable disease, including a test for infection with human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) or any other identified causative agent of acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS).
B. Any medical tests shall be performed only by any appropriately licensed medical practitioners and may include an analysis of any bodily fluids as well as an examination of the minor's person.
C. Except as otherwise provided by law, the results of such tests shall be kept strictly confidential be all medical personnel involved in the testing.

- The results of such test shall be personally delivered in a sealed envelope to the Judge of the Court in which the Sentencing Order was entered for the judge's inspection, in camera.
- The court shall notify the minor of the results of the test for infection with the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV).
- The court shall notify the victim if requested by the victim, and if the victim is under the age of 15 and if requested by the victim's parents or legal guardian, the court shall notify the victim's parents or the legal guardian, of the results of the test for infection with the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV).
- The court shall provide information on the availability of HIV testing and counseling at the G. Department of Public Health facilities (HIV/AIDS toll-free hotline (800-243-2437)) to all parties to whom the results of the testing are revealed.

H.	The cost of	any such test shall b	be paid by the county and be taxed as costs against the minor.
