Dear Members of the Local Bar:

There will be a vacancy in the position of Public Defender as of December 1, 2022, for Wabash County. If you are interested, please submit a résumé and cover letter. Submitted résumés and cover letters will be reviewed beginning November 22, 2022, and will continue until a hire is made.

Salary: Current starting salary for the Public Defender will be approximately \$135,000, which will be fixed at 90% (ninety-percent) of the Wabash County State's Attorney's salary. The Public Defender will be provided health insurance benefits, as well as contributions to IMRF.

Hours: Regular work hours will be Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. with court typically on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays. The Public Defender will not be required to work on Wabash County court holidays.

Duties: The Public Defender will be a full time position in accordance with 55 ILCS 5/3-4006 and will not be allowed to maintain a private practice.

Licensure: The Public Defender must be authorized to practice law in the State of Illinois.
